Kristin Dietz, Vice President of EdTec, and Financial Business Manager, presented the following update:

- Consolidated forecasted net income is now \$1.05M, a decrease from the previous forecast of \$152k due to the following:
 - Increase in salaries and benefits costs due to a higher number of supervision staff than originally budgeted for (\$125k consolidated increase in expense)
 - Decrease in SB 740 reimbursement per CSFA guidance (\$68k decrease in revenue at FPC, STEM and FCLA)
 - Prior year SMAA and UAR apportionment revenue received (\$29k consolidated increase in revenue)
 - Increase in contracted Special Education costs tied to Program Development Grant (\$49k increase in expense at FACS)
- Cash balances and overall fiscal health remain very strong, and all sites continue to have positive cash balances.
